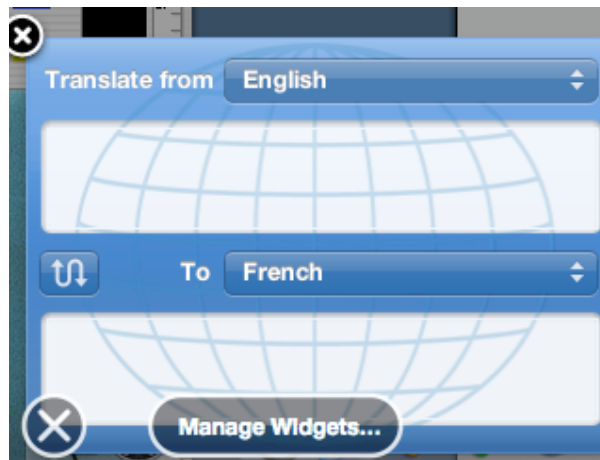
Dashboard contains mini-applications, or Widgets, that can be accessed by clicking the Dashboard icon in the Dock. Each application helps you do common tasks quickly (check weather, look up a word in the dictionary...). Most Widgets are user friendly and do not need any explanation. To exit the Dashboard, click the icon again. Dashboard keyboard shortcuts can be specified in the Dashboard & Exposé section of System Preferences. Customizing the Dashboard

- After clicking the Dashboard icon, click the icon that looks like a plus sign to enter Dashboard Customization mode
- The Widget Bar appears with icons for all your current Widgets



- If there is not enough space in the Widget Bar, there will be buttons on the right and the left allowing you to see all the available widgets
- Click a widget to activate it
- Click the X in the corner of the widget to deactivate it



- The Widget Manager (right), allows you to disable Widgets by removing the check to the left of an icon
- Click More Widgets to access Apple's Widget download site
