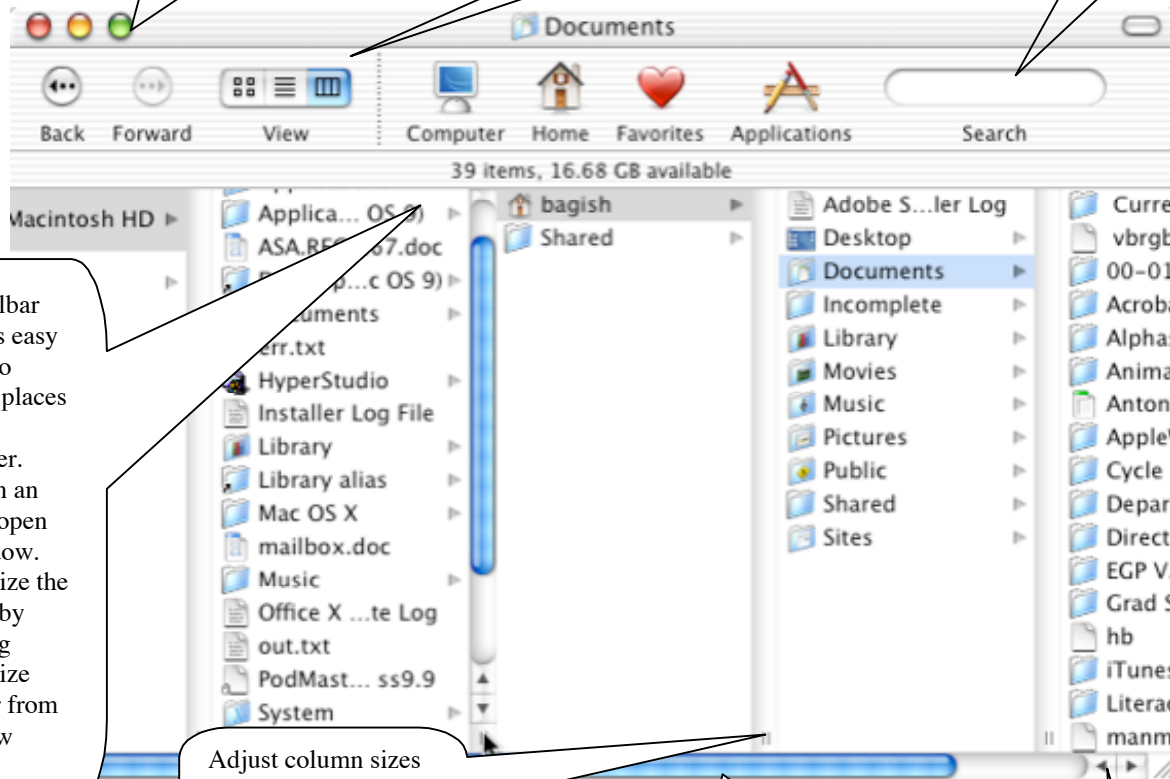


The Finder System 10.2

Click Back to go to the previously viewed enclosing folder. Click forward to go to a previously viewed inner folder inner folder.

Choose icon, list or column view for the current window. This example is in column view

Search the current window by typing in a file or application name in the Search box.



The toolbar contains easy access to various places on your computer. Click on an icon to open its window. Customize the toolbar by selecting Customize Toolbar from the View menu.

Adjust column sizes by draggin on the perpendicular grey lines.

Drag the scroll bar to scroll to the left or right of the current window.

Click to scroll.

- The red, yellow and green buttons at the top left of the window allow you to close, minimize and zoom the current window. Minimizing a window places it in your Dock. Click on it to bring it back to the desktop.
- The oval button on the top right of the window collapses or expands the button bar.
- Select Show View Options from the View menu to customize font sizes, icon sizes and more for icon, list and column view.
