

## The Finder Systems 10.3(Panther) & 10.4 (Tiger)

Click back to go to a previously visited enclosing folder. Click forward to go to a previously visited inner folder.

Choose icon, list or column view (this example is in list view).

Search by typing in a file or application name in the Search box. Click on the triangle to the right of the magnifying glass for more search options.

The sidebar contains easy access to various places on your computer. Click on an icon to open its window. Customize the sidebar by dragging a folder into the left column. Delete an item by dragging it to the desktop.

The Action button is context sensitive because it gives different options depending on what is currently selected.

Move your mouse between the columns and it will become a double arrow. Drag to resize your columns.

Click to scroll.

Drag the scroll bar to scroll to the left or right of the current window.

- The red, yellow and green buttons at the top left of the window allow you to close, minimize and zoom the current window. Minimizing a window places it in your Dock. Click on it to bring it back to the desktop.
- The oval button on the top right of the window collapses or expands the button bar.
- Drag the perimeter (silver area) of any window to move the entire window.
